Kenmore City Hall gets topped off

KENMORE — The city of Kenmore held a topping-off ceremony Friday for the Kenmore City Hall.

The \$14.4 million project, at 18114 68th Ave. N.E., involves construction of a 21,600-square-foot, two-story city hall building and 15,300 square feet of below-grade parking. Graham Contracting is general contractor, Weinstein A|U is architect and Olympic Associates is providing project management services.

KPFF Consulting Engineers is civil engineer, WSP Flack + Kurtz is mechanical and electrical engineer, Murase Associates is landscape architect and O'Brien and Co. is sustainability consultant. Interior designer is Mercedes Fernandez, Susan Zoccola is designing a public art installation for the lobby and 4Culture is helping on the public art process.
